In the Villages

Our Outreach team provides:

- Child At Risk
- School Checks
- Mother's Clubs
- Domestic violence and mental health.
- Providing Bio- Sand water filter.
- Floating gardens.







The Outreach team visits families with children under 5 to assess for malnutrition. Follow-up is scheduled every 6 months to ensure proper growth and intervention if necessary.



Children at Risk



SCHOOL CHECKS

- The school checks are comprised of 1 Doctor, 1 Dentist, and 1 Outreach Midwife
- Vision acuity and hearing is checked.
- Children are also given a physical and developmental assessment.
- Oral health is checked, and referrals given to visit the clinic for problems

MOTHER'S CLUBS

Once a month TLC Outreach leads Mother's Clubs that discuss:

- Nutrition
- Birth Control
- Domestic Abuse
- Mental Health
- Parenting






