

Objectives of IECD



OBJECTIVE 1



Improved physical, cognitive, linguistic, and socioemotional development of young children.

OBJECTIVE 2



Decreased stunting rates for children under five among the target population.

OBJECTIVE 3



Children with developmental delays and disabilities receive appropriate care in target provinces.

WASH initiative: Access to safely managed water and sanitation services is expanded

Gender Transformative Approaches: Focusing on men and women provide responsive care to children and women's empowerment






